


TEAM EVCHARGING PROGRAM





Awarded Charging Site Alternative Fuel Corridor Other High Priority EV Corridor

- Most of the nearly 50 anticipated EV fast charging stations are expected to open by late 2026.
- 47 fast charging stations from 11 developers have been awarded to date.
- \$32.2 million in federal formula funds have been awarded in KY to date.
- The first NEVI-funded fast charging station in the Southeastern US opened in Richmond in fall 2024.

National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Formula Program

NEVI was established through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) with funding provided to states to strategically deploy EV charging stations. The goal is to build an interconnected charging network across the country.

EV Charging Program Status

KY is moving forward with 47 stations with obligated federal formula funds totaling \$32.2 million for construction. Future guidance from the Federal Highway Administration is anticipated later this year.
